The catching program consists of 1 hour sessions for four weeks. Each session will include instruction and practice of catcher-specific techniques.

Each session is designed to teach a different aspect of the position. The players will participate in unique drills used by the nation's top high school and college programs and developed by the Coach Sekuterski.

Since this is not a lecture clinic, it's the type of intense, expert instruction that young catchers don't normally have access to, and at \$90 for the whole four-week program, its value is unparalleled.

The program is designed to improve the camper's skills, abilities, and other aspects. Young catchers build an invaluable foundation by increasing their understanding of the position, while experienced players learn more advanced techniques.
